Christina Embry Promoted to Assistant Supervisor in Probation and Parole District 13

FRANKFORT, Ky. (Nov. 7, 2018) – Kentucky Department of Corrections Division of Probation and Parole Director Johnathan Hall today announced the promotion of Christina Embry to District 13 assistant supervisor. District 13 covers Crittenden, Daviess, Hancock, Henderson, McLean, Muhlenberg, Ohio, Union and Webster counties. Her promotion is effective Nov. 16.

"Christina Embry has proven time and again that she has the knowledge, determination and ability to help lead the Division of Probation and Parole into the future," said Hall. "Her varied experience and willingness to accomplish all duties assigned to her have made her a valuable asset to the district and division."

In December 2001 Embry began her employment with the Department of Corrections as an office support assistant for District 13, serving both Muhlenberg and McLean counties. She was promoted in May 2009 to a probation and parole officer in District 13. Throughout her career she has served as a supervising officer for Muhlenberg County, presentence investigation officer for Muhlenberg and McLean counties, and class D officer for the Greenville office. She also serves as a field training officer for the district.

Embry is a veteran of the U.S. Air Force and Kentucky Air National Guard. Embry has developed an outstanding relationship with the court and local authorities who view her as a trusted and exceptionally knowledgeable source of information and assistance. She has worked directly with the local community in mentoring and job fairs.
