### Charece Brown Promoted to P&P District 6 Supervisor

**FRANKFORT, Ky. (Nov. 30, 2018)** – Kentucky Department of Corrections Division of Probation and Parole Director Johnathan Hall today announced the promotion of Charece Brown to supervisor of District 6.

Brown is a 12-year veteran of DOC. District 6 covers Boyle, Green, Larue, Marion, Mercer, Nelson, Taylor, and Washington counties.

“Charece Brown has proven herself as a dedicated professional time and time again,” said Hall. “Her leadership, job knowledge and dedication to success will serve her well in her new role as District 6 supervisor.”

Brown began her career with the Division of Probation and Parole as an officer in District 9 in August 2006. During her years of service, she maintained a variety of specialized caseloads. She also served as a reentry liaison for District 9 and as such spearheaded the reentry focus in the district.

In 2012 Brown was promoted to assistant supervisor in District 9. Two years later she transferred to District 14 to serve as an assistant supervisor. During her time in District 14, she also served as the public information officer and PREA investigator. She has spent the last four months in Central Office as a program administrator in the Division of Probation and Parole.

A 2000 graduate of Kentucky State University, Brown earned a bachelor’s degree in criminal justice. She is also a graduate of the 2013 Commissioner’s Executive Leadership Program. In 2017 Brown was chosen to participate in the Governor’s Minority Management Trainee Program and will graduate from the program in 2019.
