Short began her career with the Department of Corrections in Offender Information Services as an offender records specialist I in March 2012. In 2017, she promoted to procedures development coordinator for the Office of Adult Institutions. She has spent the past two years responsible for the development, revision and procedural review of all of the department’s policies and procedures. Short facilitates the procedural process through the Justice Cabinet Legal Services Department and the Legislative Research Commission.

A 2001 graduate of the University of Kentucky, Short earned a bachelor’s degree in social work. She is currently participating in the 2018 Commissioner’s Executive Leadership Program.
