LaVon Hill Promoted to Program Administrator in Interstate Compact Office

FRANKFORT, Ky. (March 18, 2019) - Kentucky Department of Corrections Director Johnathan Hall announced today the promotion of LaVon Hill to corrections program administrator for the Division of Probation and Parole's Interstate Compact Office.

"I am very pleased to announce the promotion of LaVon Hill to program administrator for Interstate Compact," said Hall. "Hill's experience in Interstate Compact and his communication skills are vital qualities for this position."

Hill began his career in December 2001 as a correctional officer with the minimum-security adult institution Frankfort Career Development Center (FCDC). In 2006, he promoted to sergeant and oversaw the Governmental Services Program, PREA and firearms training. He also acted as the Security Threat Groups (STG) coordinator, which included conducting investigations and providing trainings for staff. When FCDC closed in 2011, Hill relocated to Blackburn Correctional Complex as a sergeant.

Hill transferred to Central Office in 2012 as an administrative specialist II with the Probation and Parole Interstate Compact Office. In 2016, Hill was promoted to administrative specialist III within that office.
