(Aug. 30, 2019) - Kentucky Division of Probation and Parole Director Erica Hargis today announced that Ashley Joel "AJ" Hundley has been promoted to assistant district supervisor in District 10. District 10 has field offices in Manchester, Harlan and Pineville and covers seven counties including Bell, Clay, Harlan, Jackson, Knox, Laurel and Leslie.

"Hundley has demonstrated the skills necessary to be a valuable addition to our leadership team," said Hargis. "He has demonstrated a unique understanding of the goals and initiatives of the department and we are glad to have this opportunity to promote an employee of his caliber. We have every confidence that he will be a great asset to the division and department in this leadership role."

Hundley began his career with the Department of Corrections in May 2013 as a probation and parole officer in the Manchester office of District 10. As a probation and parole officer, he supervised a regular caseload in Jackson County. In addition to supervising a caseload, Hundley has served as a field training officer in District 10 since 2015. He has also served as one of District 10's firearms instructors since 2016 and has been one of the department's OSHA compliance officers since 2018.

In 2014, Hundley was the recipient of the District 10 Achievement Award. He was awarded the Eastern Region Employee of the Quarter in April 2018.

Hundley is a magna cum laude graduate of Eastern Kentucky University where he obtained his bachelor's degree in history.
