Scott Caswell Promoted to District 4 Assistant Supervisor

FRANKFORT, Ky. (Sept. 11, 2019) – Kentucky Department of Corrections Division of Probation and Parole Director Erica Hargis announced today the promotion of Scott Caswell to assistant supervisor in District 4. District 4 services the north central part of Jefferson County.

“Scott brings an unmatched knowledge of the PSI process and District 4 operations to this position. He is dependable, loyal, and hardworking,” said Hargis. “Scott brings a teamwork attitude to everything he does and will be a great asset not only to District 4, but the broader P&P management team.”

Caswell began his career with the Commonwealth in 2007 as an officer with the Kentucky State Police Facilities Security Branch. In 2010, he joined the Division of Probation and Parole in District 18, where he supervised a mixed caseload of probationers and parolees.

In 2011, Scott transferred to District 4, where he began conducting presentence investigations (PSIs) for the Jefferson Circuit Court. Caswell joined the PSI committee and assisted in the creation of a new PSI questionnaire packet that was introduced throughout the department in 2016. In addition to his assigned duties, Caswell acts as the field training officer and firearms instructor for his district. In 2019, he served on the Northern Region’s American Correctional Association compliance team.

Caswell received the district’s annual Kentucky Council on Crime and Delinquency (KCCD) award in 2015. He is a graduate of the 2017-18 Commissioner’s Executive Leadership Program. He received his bachelor’s degree in 2008 from Indiana University Southeast and is currently pursuing a master’s degree in criminal justice at the University of Cincinnati.
