Shayna Maybrier Promoted to District 14 Assistant Supervisor

(Oct. 21, 2019) – Kentucky Department of Corrections Director of Probation and Parole Erica Hargis announced today the promotion of Shayna Maybrier to assistant supervisor of District 14. District 14 covers Bourbon, Garrard, Harrison, Jessamine, Nicholas, Pendleton, Robertson, Scott and Woodford counties.

“Shayna Maybrier brings a well-rounded knowledge of Probation and Parole operations to this role, evident in the quality work product she consistently produces,” said Hargis. “She is task oriented and has a tremendous work ethic that will continue to help our division move forward with its mission. She is a welcome addition not only to the District 14 management team, but the division leadership as a whole.”

Maybrier began her career with the Department of Corrections in December 2012 as a probation and parole officer in the Cynthiana field office. Located in District 14, she supervised clients in Bourbon, Harrison, Robertson, Nicholas and Pendleton counties. During a time of high turnover in the district, Maybrier managed a caseload of over 120 offenders while also routinely assisting in other areas.

Maybrier has served as the class D coordinator for Bourbon County Detention Center, acted as a member of the district Fentanyl Responder Team, and facilitated reentry classes such as Moral Reconciliation Therapy (MRT) and PORTAL New Directions. In 2019, she was a member of the division’s ACA Security Team Review.

A graduate of Eastern Kentucky University and the University of Cincinnati, Maybrier has a bachelor’s degree and master’s degree in criminal justice. She received the District 14 Employee of the Quarter award in 2018 and the District 14 Achievement Award in 2019.
