Duncan Kendall Promoted to Offender Information Administrator

In addition to serving as the institutional adjustment officer for three years, Kendall acted as an institutional locksmith, PREA investigator, and chemical weapons instructor.

In 2018, Kendall promoted to an offender information specialist in Central Office. Later that year he promoted to offender information supervisor. In this role, Kendall supervised the calculations section of Offender Information Services.

Kendall is a member of the Fraternal Order of Police and of the Correctional Peace Officers Foundation.
