District 12 covers Anderson, Franklin, Spencer, Shelby, Henry, Trimble, Oldham, Carroll, Owen, Grant, and Gallatin counties. Williams will be located in the Carrollton Office.

Williams began his career with the Department of Corrections as a probation and parole officer in February 2011. He has supervised offenders in Anderson and Franklin counties, in addition to writing pre-sentence reports for Anderson and Franklin Circuit Courts. Williams has also assisted with the Franklin County Jail Class D Program and the Home Incarceration Program for District 12, giving him a well-rounded knowledge of probation and parole.

Williams was involved with the initial Portal New Directions and Moral Reconciliation Therapy (MRT) reentry classes. He has been a leader in the implementation of numerous reentry efforts in District 12. Williams is certified in Criminal Justice Information Services (CJIS) inquiry through the Kentucky State Police.

In 2009, Williams graduated from Mid-Continent College with a bachelor’s degree in psychology and counseling.
