Grant Hollenbach Promoted to District 7 Assistant Supervisor

FRANKFORT, Ky. (June 25, 2020) – Kentucky Department of Corrections Division of Probation and Parole Director Erica Hargis announced today the promotion of Grant Hollenbach to assistant district supervisor in District 7. District 7 covers Boone, Kenton and Campbell counties. Hollenbach will be located in the Campbell County office.

“Hollenbach brings a well-rounded knowledge of Probation and Parole operations to his role,” said Hargis. “Hollenbach displays a calm, levelheaded approach to supervision and is a welcome addition to leadership at District 7 as well as the P&P leadership team as a whole.”

Hollenbach began his career with the Department of Corrections as a probation and parole officer in October 2008. He has managed many different caseloads since that time, including a regular felony caseload in Boone and Campbell counties. Most recently, Hollenbach has been responsible for drafting pre-sentence investigation reports for Campbell and Kenton counties. In addition to his assistant supervisor duties, Hollenbach serves as the District 7 safety officer.
