Donna McClamroch Promoted to Assistant Director in Education Division

McClamroch worked for 34 years in public education as a teacher and administrator before retiring. While in the school system, her many roles ranged from director of student support services to assistant principal.

For the past seven years, McClamroch has worked for the Department of Corrections as an education specialist and regional education administrator at several adult institutions. In this time, she has gained experience in curriculum development and implementation, budgeting, and policy review. McClamroch was the recipient of the 2017 Commissioner’s Award due to her outstanding performance. Most recently, she had been special detailed to the assistant director position within the Division of Education.

Graduating from Western Kentucky University, McClamroch has bachelor’s degrees in English and Latin. Afterwards she earned her master’s degree in education from the University of Louisville. She went on to earn her Rank I in special education for grades 5-12, as well as her principal and superintendent certifications. In 2006, she received an additional master’s degree in educational administration. McClamroch currently serves as a school board member for Eminence Independent Schools.
