Program Description	Recovery Kentucky Centers (RKCs): The Recovery Kentucky model is a Peer-Driven model with the goal of changing how clients think, feel, and experience emotions in order to reduce substance use disorder and homelessness. The Recovery Kentucky model incorporates elements of Twelve Step Principles and Recovery Dynamics. The Recovery Kentucky model is broken into 5 Phases: Safe off the Streets (SoS), Motivational Track I (MTI), Motivational Track II (MTII), Phase I, and Phase II/Peer Mentor. During each Phase of the program clients are asked to participate in alcohol and drug education classes; participate in community meetings; hold themselves accountable for negative behaviors and breaking rules; attend self-help meetings; work a Twelve Step program; and complete written assignments. During some portions of the program clients are asked to "trudge" (walk) to classes off-site. "Trudging" represents a client going to equal lengths for their recovery as they did their addiction. **Accommodations can be made for clients unable to trudge**
	Reentry Service Centers (RSCs): Some of the RSCs utilize a RKC model which is referenced above. However, most of the RSCs utilize the Therapeutic Community Model to treat clients with substance use disorder. The TC model is a peer driven program incorporating Cognitive Behavioral Therapy in conjunction with evidence-based curriculum. Participants engage in education regarding their substance use disorder and have the opportunity to learn, practice, and apply pro-social behaviors. The community itself, through self-help and mutual support, is the principal means for promoting personal change.
Time Frame	Recovery Kentucky Centers (RKCs): The program can range from 6 to 18 months, however, DOC only requires completion through Phase I; which should typically take around 7 months to complete. Clients may choose to stay longer to complete the Phase II or Peer Mentor portion of the program. Reentry Service Centers (RSCs): The program is typically six (6) months in length and is based on the client's individual progress and participation.

Program Description	Recovery Kentucky Centers (RKCs): The clients who have completed all the requirements through Phase I with a Recovery Kentucky model program can apply and sign on for Phase II/Peer Mentorship. Phase II: Clients are eligible to seek outside employment and begin paying rent during this Phase. Clients continue to: work on maintaining sobriety; participate in community meetings; hold themselves accountable for negative behaviors and breaking rules; attending self-help meetings. Clients will also complete the 7 and 7 program which consists of mentoring and helping the SOS and MT clients in the program. Peer Mentors: The key role of Peer Mentors to act as mentors, counselors, and teachers to the program participants. The Peer Mentors are trained and assigned to teach the Recovery Dynamics curriculum to the program participants. Peer Mentors engage in all the same aspects of programming as Phase II except they are not permitted to seek outside employment during			
	the first 90-day commitment. After 90 days they are then permitted to gain outside employment as well. Reentry Service Centers (RSCs): Those individuals who have completed all the requirements for an RSC can apply to stay for Peer Mentorship. Program Description	The Volunteers of America Men's Halfway Back Program is offered to justice involved males who are on either probation or parole. The program was specifically designed to deliver the customary six-month curriculum at an accelerated pace using a modified schedule. This modification allows participants an opportunity to complete treatment in less time than traditional residential programs based on a client's individualized clinical progress as determined by the treatment team. A Treatment Team is held weekly in partnership with VOA and DOC Division of Addiction Services staff to review each client's clinical progress as it is correlated to successful program completion.
Time Frame	This is a short-term residential treatment program. Length of stay is based on level of care criteria in conjunction with treatment team review.
Program Credit	The VOA program is approved for the issuance of 45 days program good time credit when clients successfully compete the program in an average length of 45, 60, or 90 days. If it is determined by the treatment team that a client needs an additional 90 days of care (beyond the initial 90 days) resulting in the client achieving a full 180 days of treatment, then at the successful completion of those 180 days the client will be issued two (2) certificates that will each be valid for 45 days PGTC for a total of 90 days of PGTC.
Admission Criteria	Those individuals in need of treatment for Substance Use Disorder who meet the clinical and classification criteria for community custody at this level of care may participate in this program. Must meet general criteria for referral to Reentry Service Centers approved by the Department to offer Substance Use Disorder treatment programming. Referrals can be made for parolees, probationers, ISC or HIP (limited). VOA HWB Program is not equipped to handle severe mental health issues. Cases may be reviewed on an individual basis. The program is not designed to manage clients with severe, chronic medical conditions that require frequent doctors' appointments and/or treatments that would call for them to be absent from the facility. This location is unable to serve sex offenders due to women and children being housed on the same campus. Referrals are made through the Community SSC and a specification should be made on the referral form to the Placement Office requesting "VOA HWB Only."

Program Description	Comprehensive Outpatient substance use disorder treatment program can be an initial entry point into treatment or accessed as a continuum of care for offenders determined to be in need of substance use disorder services. Participants receive weekly group treatment in an outpatient setting through an agreement with the Regional Community Mental Health Centers (CMHC). Participants receive evidenced based substance use disorder curriculum and must abide by all treatment program standards including submitting to random drug screening. Due to an enhanced need in central Kentucky, the department contracts with the Hope Center to a contract of the cont
	to provide Substance Use Disorder treatment services akin to those offered in the CMHC's. Eligible candidates include MRS, probationers, parolees, HIP, and pre-trial diversions. ICOTS and Misdemeanor offenders upon approval.
	This program is broken into three phases, moving from most intensive to least intensive.
	CMHC's provide two-hour sessions, at the following schedule: PHASE 1: 3 sessions per week for 12 weeks (36 sessions/72 hours) PHASE 2: 2 sessions per week for 8 weeks (16 sessions/32 hours) PHASE 3: 1 session per week for 4 weeks (4 sessions) Thus, CMHC participants generally complete in six months (56 sessions/112 hours)

Admission	Offenders may be referred to Comprehensive Outpatient who present with a substance use disorder, which is causing multidimensional instability. Comprehensive Outpatient can be an entry point into treatment, a step down level of care, or a step up level of care. Comprehensive Outpatient would be considered for offenders who would likely benefit from structure and accountability. Offenders must be medically and mentally stable to attend treatment sessions in a group setting.
Criteria	From incarceration population: If an individual receives a recommendation of parole upon completion (PUC) of SAP, they shall be assessed by a Branch Manager or Program Administrator within the Division of Addiction Services to determine the appropriate level of care. If it is determined that the individual is appropriate for Comprehensive Outpatient and has a verified home placement, they shall be released to Comprehensive Outpatient treatment in the community. Individuals who are enrolled in SAP at the time of their release from a jail or institution can enter Comprehensive

Program Description	Community SAMAT candidates may be referred to a medical provider for evaluation for FDA approved medication to treat Opioid Use Disorder and/or Alcohol Use disorder. 	SHARE-CO is a facility for men with co-occurring Substance Use Disorders and Serious Mental Illness. The program addresses the substance use component by utilizing the peer-driven therapeutic community model that the Hope Center Men's and Women's Recovery Program has utilized for many years in its partnership with the Kentucky Department of Corrections. SHARE-CO utilizes Recovery Dynamics curriculum, integrating the twelve-step model with the peer-driven therapeutic community model.		
Program Description	Due to comorbid psychiatric conditions, individuals in the co-occurring program require certain accommodations to ensure success. This includes supplementing the peer-driven therapeutic community model with licensed mental health professionals to provide direct services and support. The program also maintains smaller therapeutic community groups, providing a less intimidating and more personal format, which allows both staff and offenders to focus on the particular needs of this group. SHARE-CO is partnered with New Vista, a local community mental health provider, to provide onsite mental health counseling as well as referrals for outpatient psychiatric counseling as needed. Other accommodations include specialized mental health groups that are specific to integrating mental health with the twelve-step model based Recovery Dynamics curriculum, while still affording offenders the opportunity to integrate into classes with the Hope Center Men's Recovery Program to provide them with the full scope of the Hope Center's services.
