Program Name	Recovery Kentucky Center (RKC) and Reentry Service Center (RSC)
Program Description	<p>Recovery Kentucky Centers (RKC): The Recovery Kentucky model is a Peer-Driven model with the goal of changing how clients think, feel, and experience emotions in order to reduce substance use disorder and homelessness. The Recovery Kentucky model incorporates elements of Twelve Step Principles and Recovery Dynamics. The Recovery Kentucky model is broken into 5 Phases: Safe off the Streets (SoS), Motivational Track I (MTI), Motivational Track II (MTII), Phase I, and Phase II/Peer Mentor. During each Phase of the program clients are asked to participate in alcohol and drug education classes; participate in community meetings; hold themselves accountable for negative behaviors and breaking rules; attend self-help meetings; work a Twelve Step program; and complete written assignments. During some portions of the program clients are asked to “trudge” (walk) to classes off-site. “Trudging” represents a client going to equal lengths for their recovery as they did their addiction. **Accommodations can be made for clients unable to trudge**</p> <p><i>Recovery Kentucky has a partnership with Kentucky Housing and if applicable client’s will be required to follow HUD guidelines for housing and rent.</i></p> <p>Reentry Service Centers (RSCs): Some of the RSCs utilize a RKC model which is referenced above. However, most of the RSCs utilize the Therapeutic Community Model to treat clients with substance use disorder. The TC model is a peer driven program incorporating Cognitive Behavioral Therapy in conjunction with evidence-based curriculum. Participants engage in education regarding their substance use disorder and have the opportunity to learn, practice, and apply pro-social behaviors. The community itself, through self-help and mutual support, is the principal means for promoting personal change.</p>
Time Frame	<p>Recovery Kentucky Centers (RKC): The program can range from 6 to 18 months, however, DOC only requires completion through Phase I; which should typically take around 7 months to complete. Clients may choose to stay longer to complete the Phase II or Peer Mentor portion of the program.</p> <p>Reentry Service Centers (RSCs): The program is typically six (6) months in length and is based on the client’s individual progress and participation.</p>
Program Credit	This program receives 90 days program credit upon completion.
Admission Criteria	<p>Applicant has evidence of a substance use disorder that requires treatment.</p> <p>Applicant shall be deemed appropriate for this level of care by clinical staff within the Division of Addiction Services.</p> <p>Must be medically and psychologically stable – applicable to RKC placement only.</p>

	<p>From incarcerated population: If an individual receives a recommendation of parole upon completion (PUC) of SAP or is determined eligible for HIP, they shall be assessed by a Branch Manager or Program Administrator within the Division of Addiction Services to determine the appropriate level of care. If it is determined that the individual is appropriate for community/RKC/RSC they shall be released to treatment in the community. Individuals who are enrolled in SAP at the time of their release can enter community RKC/RSC with recognition for the treatment already completed.</p> <p>From community population: The court or supervising probation/parole officer can refer a client to the community Social Service Clinicians (SSC) to determine the appropriate level of care. Applicant shall have a custody status of Level 1 (community) – applicable to RSC placement only. While enrolled in SAP a client may enroll in one (1) other evidence-based program. In addition anyone eligible to attend GED may do so and this will not count as the one additional program.</p>

Program Name	Recovery Kentucky Center (RKC) and Reentry Service Center (RSC) Mentor (SAP Mentor)
Program Description	<p>Recovery Kentucky Centers (RKC): The clients who have completed all the requirements through Phase I with a Recovery Kentucky model program can apply and sign on for Phase II/Peer Mentorship. Phase II: Clients are eligible to seek outside employment and begin paying rent during this Phase. Clients continue to: work on maintaining sobriety; participate in community meetings; hold themselves accountable for negative behaviors and breaking rules; attending self-help meetings. Clients will also complete the 7 and 7 program which consists of mentoring and helping the SOS and MT clients in the program. Peer Mentors: The key role of Peer Mentors to act as mentors, counselors, and teachers to the program participants. The Peer Mentors are trained and assigned to teach the Recovery Dynamics curriculum to the program participants. Peer Mentors engage in all the same aspects of programming as Phase II except they are not permitted to seek outside employment during the first 90-day commitment. After 90 days they are then permitted to gain outside employment as well.</p> <p><i>Recovery Kentucky has a partnership with Kentucky Housing and if applicable client's will be required to follow HUD guidelines for housing and rent.</i></p> <p>Reentry Service Centers (RSCs): Those individuals who have completed all the requirements for an RSC can apply to stay for Peer Mentorship. They begin to give back to the community by acting as role models, mentors, and teachers to the other phases in the program.</p>
Time Frame	<p>Recovery Kentucky Centers (RKC): Phase II can range from 1 to 6 months. Peer Mentor "commitments" are broken into 90-day contracts. Clients can choose to participate in one or more Peer Mentor "commitments". DOC requires a full six (6) month commitment in order to be eligible for good time.</p> <p>Reentry Service Centers (RSCs): The program is typically six (6) months in length. DOC requires a full six (6) month commitment in order to be eligible for good time.</p>
Program Credit	This program receives 90 days program credit upon completion.
Admission Criteria	<p>Must have completed all previous program requirements and applied for Phase II or peer mentorship. While enrolled in SAP Mentor or Phase II a client may enroll in one (1) other evidence-based program. In addition anyone eligible to attend GED may do so and this will not count as the one additional program.</p>

Program Description	<p>A client on misdemeanor supervision, pre-trial diversion, probation, MRS (mandatory reentry supervision), or parole may be referred to a DOC Approved Provider for Substance Use Disorder Treatment.</p> <p>The goal of Approved Providers is to provide treatment for substance use disorder through a community provider that utilizes a level of care of 2 or higher upon the clinically appropriate referral from a Division of Addiction Services staff. Levels of treatment eligible include levels 2 and 3.</p>		
Time Frame	Will vary based on clinical need, but may include multiple levels of care. Eligible clients will be reviewed by Division of Addiction Services staff to assist in identifying community providers and ensuring treatment is implemented and monitored. Participants remain in programming as clinically appropriate.		
Program Credit	<p>Program Credit for this program will be determined by the levels of care completed as follows and for individuals on court ordered release, at the sentencing Judges discretion:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ASAM Levels 3 – 30 days of program good time credit upon completion ASAM Levels 2 – 60 days of program good time credit upon completion Client may receive credit for each level of care once per treatment episode Addiction Services maintains the ability to grant credit at the discretion of the division if deemed appropriate.
