Program Name	Recovery Kentucky Center (RKC) and Halfway House (HWH)
Program Description	<p><b>Recovery Kentucky Centers (RKC):</b>            The Recovery Kentucky model is a Peer-Driven model with the goal of changing how clients think, feel, and experience emotions in order to reduce substance use disorder and homelessness. The Recovery Kentucky model incorporates elements of Twelve Step Principles and Recovery Dynamics. The Recovery Kentucky model is broken into 5 Phases: Safe off the Streets (SoS), Motivational Track I (MTI), Motivational Track II (MTII), Phase I, and Phase II/Peer Mentor. During each Phase of the program clients are asked to participate in alcohol and drug education classes; participate in community meetings; hold themselves accountable for negative behaviors and breaking rules; attend self-help meetings; work a Twelve Step program; and complete written assignments. During some portions of the program clients are asked to “trudge” (walk) to classes off-site. “Trudging” represents a client going to equal lengths for their recovery as they did their addiction. **Accommodations can be made for clients unable to trudge**</p> <p><b><i>Recovery Kentucky has a partnership with Kentucky Housing and if applicable client’s will be required to follow HUD guidelines for housing and rent.</i></b></p> <p><b>Halfway Houses (HWHs):</b>            Some of the HWHs utilize a RKC model which is referenced above. However, most of the HWHs utilize the Therapeutic Community Model to treat clients with substance use disorder. The TC model is a peer driven program incorporating Cognitive Behavioral Therapy in conjunction with evidence-based curriculum. Participants engage in education regarding their substance use disorder and have the opportunity to learn, practice, and apply pro-social behaviors. The community itself, through self-help and mutual support, is the principal means for promoting personal change.</p>
Time Frame	<p>Recovery Kentucky Centers (RKC): The program can range from 6 to 18 months, however, DOC only requires completion through Phase I; which should typically take around 7 months to complete. Clients may choose to stay longer to complete the Phase II or Peer Mentor portion of the program.</p> <p>Halfway Houses (HWHs): The program is typically six (6) months in length and is based on the client’s individual progress and participation.</p>
Program Credit	This program receives <b>90</b> days program credit upon completion.
Admission Criteria	<p>Applicant has evidence of a substance use disorder that requires treatment.</p> <p>Applicant shall be deemed appropriate for this level of care by clinical staff within the Division of Addiction Services.</p> <p>Must be medically and psychologically stable – applicable to RKC placement only.</p>

	<p>From incarcerated population:          If an individual receives a recommendation of parole upon completion (PUC) of SAP or is determined eligible for HIP, they shall be assessed by a Branch Manager or Program Administrator within the Division of Addiction Services to determine the appropriate level of care. If it is determined that the individual is appropriate for community/RKC/HWH they shall be released to treatment in the community. Individuals who are enrolled in SAP at the time of their release can enter community RKC/HWH with recognition for the treatment already completed.</p> <p>From community population:          The court or supervising probation/parole officer can refer a client to the community Social Service Clinicians (SSC) to determine the appropriate level of care.          Applicant shall have a custody status of Level 1 (community) – applicable to HWH placement only.          While enrolled in SAP a client may enroll in one (1) other evidence-based program. In addition anyone eligible to attend GED may do so and this will not count as the one additional program.</p>

Program Name	Recovery Kentucky Center (RKC) and Halfway House (HWH) Mentor (SAP Mentor)
Program Description	<p><b>Recovery Kentucky Centers (RKC):</b> The clients who have completed all the requirements through Phase I with a Recovery Kentucky model program can apply and sign on for Peer Mentorship. The key role of Peer Mentors to act as mentors, role models, and teachers to the program participants. The Peer Mentors are trained and assigned to teach the Recovery Dynamics curriculum to the program participants. After 90 days, Peer Mentors are permitted to gain outside employment.</p> <p><i>Recovery Kentucky has a partnership with Kentucky Housing and if applicable client's will be required to follow HUD guidelines for housing and rent.</i></p> <p><b>Halfway House (HWHs):</b> Those individuals who have completed all the requirements for an HWH can apply to stay for Peer Mentorship. They begin to give back to the community by acting as role models, mentors, and teachers to the other phases in the program.</p> <p>Peer Mentors for both RKC and HWHs are responsible for the following (but not limited to):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Model prosocial behaviors and attitudes;</li> <li>○ Model success or failure through trial-and-error learning process;</li> <li>○ Model support and guidance to peers and staff in community;</li> <li>○ Model new behaviors, attitudes, and responsible living on a daily basis;</li> <li>○ Model appropriate accountability to bring awareness to Criminal &amp; Addictive Thinking Patterns and behaviors for self and peers;</li> <li>○ Model leadership through tasks assigned to create clear and understandable expectations;</li> </ul> <p>Complete work in Hazelden “Now That You’re Sober”<sup>®</sup> workbook or other evidenced-based curriculum.</p>
Time Frame	Recovery Kentucky Centers (RKC) and Halfway Houses (HWH): DOC requires a full six (6) month commitment to be eligible for good time.
Program Credit	This program receives <b>90</b> days program credit upon completion.
Admission Criteria	<p>Must have completed all previous program requirements and applied for peer mentorship.</p> <p>Peer Mentor Agreement (and other applicable documentation) must be sent to <a href="mailto:DOCSAP.RKCRSCDocuments@ky.gov">DOCSAP.RKCRSCDocuments@ky.gov</a> email, providing notification of client's intent to participate in SAP Mentor program.</p> <p>While enrolled in SAP Mentor a client may enroll in one (1) other evidence-based program. Program Description	<p>A client on misdemeanor supervision, pre-trial diversion, probation, MRS (mandatory reentry supervision), or parole may be referred to a DOC Approved Provider for Substance Use Disorder Treatment.</p> <p>The goal of Approved Providers is to provide treatment for substance use disorder through a community provider that utilizes a level of care of 2 or higher upon the clinically appropriate referral from a Division of Addiction Services staff. Levels of treatment eligible include levels 2 and 3.</p>							
Time Frame	Will vary based on clinical need, but may include multiple levels of care. Eligible clients will be reviewed by Division of Addiction Services staff to assist in identifying community providers and ensuring treatment is implemented and monitored. Participants remain in programming as clinically appropriate.

This program also maintains smaller therapeutic community groups, providing a less intimidating and more personal format, which allows both staff and offenders to focus on the particular needs of the clients.</p> <p>During some portions of the program clients may be asked to “trudge” (walk) to classes off-site. “Trudging” represents a client going to equal lengths for their recovery as they did their addiction. **Accommodations can be made for clients unable to trudge**</p> <p><b><i>Recovery Kentucky has a partnership with Kentucky Housing and if applicable client’s will be required to follow HUD guidelines for housing and rent.</i></b></p>		
Time Frame	SHARE-SMI is a minimum of six (6) month with options for aftercare services. Completion is dependent on client needs and progress.
