


Less Lethal Instructor Course

Open Records Training

It is also appropriate for anyone who makes decisions concerning the release of records or handles a response to a request including wardens, deputy wardens, unit administrators, PREA compliance staff, HR staff who handle production of personnel files, Business Office staff, CTO, Internal Affairs staff, Medical Records staff, Property Officers who maintain IM property records, District Supervisors, and Assistant District Supervisors. 
