

Steps Taken at Kentucky State Reformatory (KSR)



KSR is a multi-custody male prison located in LaGrange, Kentucky (Oldham County) with 247 employees, 115 contract staff, and a total inmate population of 936. KSR's primary mission is to be a specialized institution to provide extensive mental health and medical services to inmates within the system.

- The prison is operating under controlled containment in order to conduct mass testing. With these measures, we have in essence locked down the prison by dormitory, while still allowing the things most important to inmates such as time to make phone calls, send electronic mail, and access to the canteen.
- We have a screening process for staff to check for COVID-19 symptoms every day upon entry. Anyone entering a DOC facility is required to sanitize hands, receive a temperature scan, and answer questions regarding recent travel activity and current health symptoms.
- We have significantly increased sanitation at the prison using germicide and a bleach solution multiple times a day. In addition, hand sanitizer dispensers have been installed in all dormitories and bottles of germicide and extra soap have been distributed to each inmate.
- Foot sanitation systems have been placed at the front entrance and in the front of each dormitory so inmates and staff can kill any germs on their shoes.
- Cloth masks for inmates and staff were provided in early April. Two extra masks were later provided to ensure the inmates have a fresh one available. Masks are mandatory for all staff and inmates. In addition to the masks, the staff wear gloves, protective gowns and face shields in the housing units where positive inmates are housed.
- We have established regular medical checks for all inmates. Our medical staff go to each dormitory and check on the men individually. Medically vulnerable inmates are closely monitored by medical staff and checked regularly throughout the day.
- If any inmate becomes symptomatic for any illness, not just COVID-19, and the prison medical staff cannot handle their care adequately, they are transferred to the hospital.
