DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS
Addiction Services of Kentucky

The Division of Addiction Services is responsible for the clinical and administrative oversight of all Substance Use Disorder (SUD) treatment related to inmates, parolees, and probationers within our care as determined by statute. This oversight includes treatment in prisons, jails, Reentry Service Centers (RSCs), Recovery Kentucky Centers (RKC), and Intensive Outpatient Programs (IOPs) through a partnership with regional Community Mental Health Centers (CMHCs). Substance Use Disorder clinical determination for probationers and parolees through a network of Social Services Clinicians in the Probation & Parole districts are also included in the oversight.

Community based Social Services Clinicians are encouraged to utilize all evidence-based resources within their respective regions. This may include agencies not formally contracted with the Department.

For individuals who have never had a license or state ID:

1. One (1) proof of identity document
2. One (1) proof of Social Security number (first time and out of state applicants must bring their social security card as proof)
3. One (1) proof of the applicant's KY residency (Two are required if applying for a REAL ID)
4. If your current legal name, date of birth, or gender is different than what is displayed on your identity or lawful status document, you must show legal proof of the changes. Your name must be updated on your social security card before applying for a driver's license or state identification.

For individuals who were released from DOC on HIP, Parole, Serve Out, Shock Probation, or Pardon: *HB 428: Inmate ID Cards*

- A release letter that shall contain full legal name, discharge/release date, signature, SS #, DOB, present KY address, and physical description.
- Copy of resident record card and parole certificate (or notice of discharge)
- A photograph of the offender (printed on plastic card or paper, ID Letter will have picture)
- Certified copy of Birth Certificate

HOMELESS IDENTIFICATION CARD

The ID can be obtained at any Driver Licensing Regional Office

Per KRS 18.412(7) "...the regional office shall issue a color photo personal identification card to any person who is a Kentucky resident and who resides in the county who complies with the provisions of this selection and who applies in person."

It also says that "An application for a personal identification card shall be accompanied the same information as is required for an operator license" ... "except if a person does not have a fixed, permanent address, the person may use as proof of residency a signed letter from a homeless shelter, health care facility, or social service agency currently providing the person treatment or services attesting that the person is a resident in Kentucky."

 - Certificate from an approved driver training program if applying for driver's license.

- ☐ Early enlistment for military service, if applicable

Must have held a valid permit for 180+ days, passed a skills test, and completed a driver training program to obtain a permanent license. Must provide a valid U.S. Uniformed Services ID or proof of military enlistment.

Veteran/military

- ☐ If you wish to note veteran status on a credential, you must submit a DD-214, DD-256, DD-257, or NGB-22.

Other

*If you do not receive mail at your physical address, you will need proof of post office box for mailing address. **CANNOT BE USED AS A PHYSICAL ADDRESS PROOF.***

*If you will no longer drive **OR** if you are a CDL driver dropping a class, endorsement or restriction, you must present a voluntarily surrendered affidavit.*

- ☐ Motorcycle License

If you are a motorcycle permit holder applying for a motorcycle license, you must have a motorcycle safety course completion certificate/affidavit

- ☐ Felon Release

VALID PROOF ONLY FOR STANDARD LICENSE

Must present a certified U.S. Birth Certificate and a Felon Release Letter issued by the Federal Bureau of Prisons located in Kentucky, KY Department of Corrections, Division of Probation and Parole, or the U.S. Probation Office.

REAL ID

In May 2025, standard licenses will no longer meet federal REAL ID Act requirements for Kentuckians to board U.S. domestic flights or enter select federal facilities. New security standards for identity credentials

were recommended by the 9/11 Commission to prevent the fraudulent use of reproduction of licenses and IDs. For more information on the REAL ID, <http://drive.ky.gov/REALID>

- What to expect when requesting a REAL ID
 - Required Documents for REAL ID:
 - (1) Proof of identity
 - (1) Proof of social security
 - (2) Proof of residency
 - Temporary Document: applicants will leave a regional licensing office with a 30-day temporary printed document and their current ID card/license to use until the requested REAL ID arrives in the mail. The temporary document may be used to board U.S. commercial flights if shown with the current card. While many businesses accept temporary documents for general identification purposes, it is advised to check beforehand if you plan to use the document as a form of ID.
 - Arrive In The Mail: The requested credential will arrive in the mail at the address provided by the applicant 10-15 days later.
 - Extended Shelf-Life: REAL ID credentials are available in four or eight-year lifespans.
 - New Pricing: The cost of the REAL ID accounts for the extended renewal cycle and additional security improvements.

OBTAINING A SOCIAL SECURITY CARD

To replace a social security card, the SS-5 form must be completed. This form can be obtained on the Internet (www.ssa.gov), through the local social security office, or by calling 1-800-772-1213.

PROPER IDENTIFICATION IS REQUIRED! (Driver's license, marriage or divorce record, military records, employer ID card, adoption record, insurance policy, passport, health insurance card, school ID card, parole certificate)

- For a replacement card, one identifying document is necessary. It will be the same number as the old card.
- For a name change, documentation of old and new name is necessary
- For a new card, documentation proving age, citizenship or lawful alien status, and identification are necessary.

No photocopies of documents are accepted. The original documents or copies certified by the custodian of record are required. Notarized copies are not acceptable.

You can request your replacement social security card online at www.ssa.gov/myaccount if you:

- Are a U.S. citizen
- Have a driver's license or state-issued identification card from one of the participating sites or the District of Columbia
- Have a U.S. mailing address
- Have a *my* Social Security account
- Don't require changes to your name
